BOOK BANK

The one of the important feature of the college is that this college is situated in a rural area and most of the enrollment in the college is from the students having lower income and belonging to underprivileged class. Majority of the students in the college are girls. The library of college is providing them books at regular basis. Regular books of the library are available at lesser proportion, however, it was found insufficient as most of the students were not able to afford to buy books. Book banks have a positive impact on students' education and help bridge the gap between urban and rural education. With the help of book bank, many underprivileged students have been able to study for their college effectively as they have ready access to the required books for free, which otherwise would not have been possible.

Getting access to educational books can often be challenging for students, especially those from underprivileged backgrounds. This is where "book banks" come in as a valuable resource. Book banks are repositories of textbooks and reference books. There is proper mechanism to identify the poor and needy students and after identifying the needy students they can get issue the books from the in charge of the book bank for the whole session/semester and after examination they return the books and they are issued books for the new semester. Taking into consideration the vision and mission of the institution, the college has formed the "Book Bank" to help the student of weaker sections of the society by giving books prescribed for the respective courses. The chief aim of this practice is to bring poor students in the main stream of education. The book bank is maintained from the extra complimentary copies received by teachers and books donated by the old students. In our institution there are more than Five Hundred books in the book bank. The practice of donating books among the students inculcates among them to serve the society.

GUEST LECTURE

Getting guest lecturers in colleges are very useful for every student. Guest lectures are a highly useful medium to provide exceptional knowledge to students, it also adds an extra variety to the classroom routine and colleges put a lot of emphasis on the importance of Guest lectures. The Guest lecturers are the "real-world" arriving in the classroom in order to make classes more interesting. Guest speakers share their experiences and engage students in a dialogue. Dialogue with experts helps students to develop multiple skills like critical thinking, reasoning, planning for the future, etc.. In a guest lecture, students get new perspectives and opinions that are often missed in a regular class. A guest lecture gives students a better opportunity to learn about an explicit topic in a way that gets them involved in the class and actively join in a more convenient way of teaching. Some students seize the opportunity and start practicing what they learn in lectures and build an advanced skill set which helps them in their future. Students follow regularly scheduled classes and sometimes it can feel a bit monotonous and boring. Guest lecture breaks monotony and updates student's interest about career opportunities & career paths in new domains.
