In this Programme Dr. Kuldeep Singh Chandel (Principal of SVN College) was the Resource Person. He reflected on the topic "National Education Policy-2020 School Education, Foundational Literacy and Numeracy" During his speech he explained, and highlighted the vision and framework for school Education in our country. He emphasized several key aspects such as early childhood care and education, foundational literacy, numeracy and a holistic approach to learning, He revealed that Aim of policy is to promote critical thinking, creativity and problem solving skill among students. Further, He Placed significant emphasis on the 5+3+3+4 pattern in school Education which signifies the reorganization of the school Education into four stages:

- 01. Foundational stage(ages 3-8)
- 02. Preparatory stage (ages 8-11)
- 03. Middle stage (ages 11-14)
- 04. Secondary stage (ages 14-18)

After this Resource Person explored the foundational stage and highlighted the key points of rest of three stages. About the foundational stage, Resource Person remarked that child (age 3-8 Year should focused on Early childhood care and education (ECCE), and need to be recognized the crucial role of early years in a child's development. It aims to provide a play-based, activity based and discovery –based Learning environment.

Further, Resource Person indicated about preparatory stage (3 years), this stage aims to build on the foundational stage and facilitate the development of Numeracy, Literacy, and social and emotional skill. About the middle stage (3 Years), Resource person told that

main emphasizes on critical thinking, and a multi disciplinary approach to education. Further resource person reflected about secondary stage (4 Year) that it provided a flexible Curriculum with wide range of subject choices. It emphasized holistic development, vocational skill and integration of technology in education. On this occasion trainee teachers and staff of SVN College were present and there and participated in programme actively.
